Your donations include a custom bronze plaque inscribed with a personal sentiment or name, and placement of the bench or tree in a park or along a greenway in Roanoke County. Whether a particular park holds special memories or symbolizes your loved one's values, this long lasting memorial will share those sentiments with all who visit the park.

Roanoke County Parks, Recreation and Tourism will take care of all the details, installation of the bench or tree and its maintenance. Your loved one's memory will then become a part of the County's unique and beautiful landscape.

COMMEMORATIVE BENCHES

The commemorative bench style and color will be chosen by park administration in order to maintain consistency throughout each park.

Upon inquiry, Roanoke County Parks, Recreation and Tourism will schedule a meeting to determine the location of the bench.

- Bench locations are subject to approval by park administration

BENCHES REQUIRE AN EIGHT TO TEN WEEK LEAD TIME FROM DATE OF APPROVAL TO FINAL INSTALLATION.

- Benches are installed in the order of approval.

Price: \$2,000

- Includes a bench made from recycled materials with a life-time guarantee, a commemorative plaque, pavers, installation, and maintenance)

COMMEMORATIVE TREES

A tree may be selected from a list of native tree species approved by Roanoke County Parks, Recreation and Tourism.

- Tree species and planting locations are subject to approval of park administration

Price: \$750 *Subject to market conditions

- Includes minimum 1.5 inch caliper tree, commemorative plaque, installation, and maintenance

Depending upon the appropriate planting season of the tree species selected, commemorative trees will be planted on an annual basis each fall. Inquiries received by July 1st are guaranteed fall planting in the same calendar year. Inquiries received after July 1st may be subject to planting in the fall of the succeeding calendar year.
